Team Rules

Team rules will be discussed in detail at the first parents meeting at the beginning of the season however, here are a few basic ones:

- Hockey should take priority over all other extra curricular activities to the best of our ability.
- Always come to compete. Give your maximum effort at all practices and games.
- Be respectful to everyone on and off the ice (Coaches, Officials, and all players)
- Arrive 40 minutes before practice (ready 10 minutes before ice time) Early Practices can be exceptions as schools end at different times for individuals.
- Arrive 1 hour before games (ready 10 minutes before ice time) Further pre game details to be provided in parents meeting.
- Everything we do is "<u>Team First</u>". Teams can be like a family. We protect, respect and help our family.

Evaluations and Tryouts

The tryouts primary focus for selecting the 25-26 Crusaders U14 team will be centered around teamwork, effort and positive attitudes. We will be looking for individuals that play the game of hockey working as a team and have the drive to put 110% every shift and practice with the common team goal in heart and in mind. With wearing the Crusaders crest and the family names on the back, respect to the other players, coaches, and officials both on and off the ice is a must. The expectation for each player is to show up at the rink ready to play "Crusader Hockey" which means playing with a positive attitude and the willingness to always learn, improve and contribute as part of the team.

Additionally, evaluations will also consider active listening skills, ability to follow instructions, and the ability to recover when mistakes are made. As stated before, the game of hockey is a game of mistakes. We will **always** make mistakes. Part of the evaluation will be based on how we recover, learn and adapt to grow from mistakes made, not from the mistakes itself.

Final Note

The word and definition of <u>success</u> does not mean "winning" all the time. Success comes in many different forms. Success for us will begin in the smaller victories and grow into the bigger ones throughout the year during our practices, games and tournaments.
